- 4. DO NOT feed the animals anything other than what is provided by us. This helps us to keep our animals healthy.
- 5. Please refrain from picking grasses and weeds to feed our animals.
- 6. Ensure all garbage is placed in garbage cans or is taken home with you. Garbage can blow into cages and cause illness and injury to our animals.
